SMITHVILLE GRASSLAND REVITALIZATION PROJECT

The Smithville Grassland Revitalization Project is designed to restore and recreate nearly 2,300 acres of savannas and warm season grasses in Bauman Park around Smithville Lake.

The project focuses on four goals:

- To recreate a grassland plant/wildlife community from pastureland and cropland
- To recreate a savanna, dry plant/wildlife community from degraded savanna areas
- To improve habitat for concerned wildlife species
- To create a positive public outlook on conservation awareness of critical terrestrial plant communities, threatened/endangered wildlife species, and wildlife management practices

This brochure is an introduction to the more common grasses and forbs, or broad-leaved plants, that can be seen in Bauman Park.

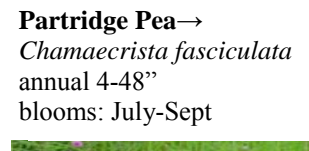

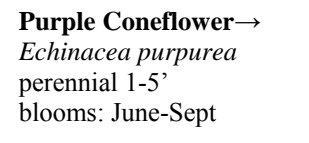

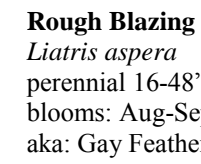
