


# CLAY COUNTY CONSTITUTIONAL PROCEDURE TIMELINE



Constitution Committee members appointed. 11/18/19

11/18/19

The Constitution Commission question – whether a Constitution Commission should be appointed by the Circuit Court – is submitted by the Clay County Commission to the Board of Election to be placed on the ballot for a public vote during the 4/07/20 election.

1/28/20

If the majority of the voters in Clay County approve appointing a Constitution Commission, The Clay County Circuit Court Judges are charged with appointing 14 residents, of equal political party divide, to form the Constitution Commission and draft the final proposed Constitution (must occur within 60 days after the Board of Election certifies election results, which is on or around 6/07/20).

6/07/20

The Clay County Board of Election must publish, in the newspaper, the full text of the proposed Constitution for Clay County voters to review for three weeks prior to the November general election, starting 9/22/20.

9/22/20, 9/28/20, 10/6/20

Clay County Citizens vote in the General Election whether to adopt the proposed Constitution. If the majority of voters approve adoption of the Constitution, it will go into effect on the date set forth in the Constitution.
