**CREATION OF CLAY COUNTY COMMISSION CONSTITUTIONAL
CHARTER COMMITTEE
COMMISSION**

Whereas, Clay County is a county of the first classification; and

Whereas, Article VI Section 18(m) of the Missouri Constitution and Section 66.700 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri permit counties of the first classification to adopt a constitutional charter; and

Whereas, the Clay County Commission desires to create a Constitutional Charter Committee to consider the adoption of a constitutional charter and formulate the form and content of the same; and

Whereas, the Clay County Commission believes the citizens of Clay County should have a role in creating any such constitutional charter considered for adoption; and

Whereas, the Clay County Commission seeks to solicit such public input by and through the aforementioned Constitutional Charter Committee; and

Whereas, the facts cited above have led the Clay County Commission to determine that a Constitutional Charter Committee should be created.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF CLAY
COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:**

The Clay County Commission hereby creates the Constitutional Charter Committee as a committee of the Clay County Commission. The Constitutional Charter Committee is hereby authorized and directed to convene in order to draft a constitutional charter and solicit public input with respect to the same. The Constitutional Charter Committee is authorized to employ the County Counselor to provide any assistance that it may require.

The Constitutional Charter Committee shall hold its organizational meeting no later than _____, and elect its Chair, Vice-Chair, and Secretary.
